

Regulations for Institutional and Program Self-Evaluations at I-Shou University

Adopted on May 24, 2006 at the second meeting of the University Administration Council in the second semester of the academic year 2005

Adopted on February 20, 2008 at the first meeting of the University Administration Council in the second semester of the academic year 2007

Amendments to the Regulations ratified and promulgated by the President on July 11, 2010

Amendments to Articles 1 and 3 ratified and promulgated by the President on April 6, 2017

- Article 1 The Regulations for Institutional and Program Self-Evaluations at I-Shou University (hereinafter referred to as “the Regulations”) are made pursuant to Article 5 of the University Act with the aim of improving teaching quality and teaching outcome while adhering to the educational objective, educational philosophy, and developmental characteristics and directions of the University.
- Article 2 The purpose of the institutional self-evaluation is to showcase the overall performance on teaching, research, service, and administration while adhering to the educational philosophy and vision of the University. The program self-evaluation aims for self-improvement and self-enhancement, and the items being evaluated are the educational objective, curriculum, teaching, faculty qualifications, learning resources, learning outcomes, and the alumni follow-up mechanism.
- Article 3 The results of the institutional self-evaluation is for the adjustment and improvement of overall university development, whereas the results of the program self-evaluation serves as an important reference to adjustments in departmental annual budgets, the admission quota, and the allocation of resources.
- Article 4 The cycle of an institutional self-evaluation is subject to the schedule of the institutional evaluation conducted by the Ministry of Education and the mid-term university development plan. The program self-evaluation can be divided into the yearly evaluation and the multi-year evaluation.
- Article 5 The institutional self-evaluation shall be conducted in accordance with the

comprehensive evaluation plan of the Ministry of Education. The program self-evaluation includes a yearly evaluation (the internal evaluation) and a multi-year evaluation (the external evaluation); the yearly evaluation covers a documentation review, and the multi-year evaluation covers a self-evaluation and an on-site visit.

Article 6 The regulations for institutional self-evaluations and for program self-evaluations will be made separately.

Article 7 The Regulations become effective on the third day of promulgation after being adopted by the University Administration Council and ratified by the President.

Note: In the event of any disputes or misunderstanding as to the interpretation of the language or terms of these Regulations, the Chinese language version shall prevail.
